Masking	Masks will be required for all staff and students to start the school year off as required by the Bay Mills Executive Council and our school board. This could change throughout the year depending on the COVID 19 statistics in our region. Masks will be made available for any individual who would like one.
Physical Distancing	Physical distancing to the extent possible.
Visitors	Entry to the Office permitted by those with reasonable purpose. Classroom visitation may be permitted by appointment.
Cleaning	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Daily surface cleaning 2. Evening deep cleaning as needed 3. Continued cleaning of surfaces as classes change 4. Frequent handwashing by staff and students 5. Hand sanitizer dispensers in every space
Quarantine Protocols	<p>When notified of a positive case of COVID-19 within the OCS community, school leadership will work with the local health department to enforce the safety protocols and requirements for those identified as being within range of the positive individual.</p> <p>Subject to change based on requirements of Chippewa County Health Department and Bay Mills Indian Community.</p>
Screening/Entry Protocols	Staff, students, and visitors are encouraged to self-screen for COVID-19 symptoms daily. The very best safeguard is for individuals experiencing symptoms to stay home.
Athletics	Operate athletics based on requirements set forth by the MHSAA, BMIC and our board of education.
Communication	Posting of plan on website, social media, and available in the offices when any changes are made.
Updates/Changes	Grant Superintendent the ability to change the plan following conferencing with governing entities and consultation with the Board President. Superintendent to update the Board at regularly scheduled Board meetings.
