

Good afternoon OCS Families,

We are now entering our second week of online Friday instruction. Information was sent home regarding Friday zoom meetings as well as login instructions at each grade level. Every student has been assigned a Chromebook, charger and backpack. These will be sent home every evening and students MUST return with them the next school day.

Kindergarten, first, second, fifth and sixth grade will log in at 10:00 a.m.

Third and fourth grade will log in at 9:00 a.m.

Grades 7 through 12 will log in from 9:00 a.m. to 9:15 with their homeroom teacher. Students in grades 7-12 who have below a 75% in any class, are expected to log in with the subject specific teacher to receive help in the courses they are struggling in from 9:15 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

Besides the zoom meetings there will be assignments in our online learning portal, Canvas, for the students to complete each Friday. If a student receives title one or special education services, those teachers will be in contact with you regarding extra support. The teacher letters are also posted on our school website at ojibwe.eupschools.org for your reference. If you would like a parent login for Canvas or Illuminate, please contact your child's teacher and provide an email address and valid phone number so we are able to set you up in the system and give you a code for access.

Friday's are still school days. It is mandatory that students sign in to the classroom zoom meetings and do their Canvas work so they may be counted for attendance. If you have any questions, please contact your child's teacher.

We have not had a case of COVID-19 within our school yet, however, with the rise of COVID-19 in our region, we would like to remind to to stay diligent in your handwashing, social distancing, and mask wearing to help prevent the spread.
